

Welcome Guide to WGA Golf

This is our website where you will find everything you need to know about the WGA. It includes membership directories, league board members, descriptions of weekly events, WGA golf rules and guidelines and a calendar of all WGA/League events. Familiarize yourself with it and use it often.

- **Scheduling**

- Prior to each month, the scheduler will email a survey requesting each member to indicate which days she would like to play. Several days before play, the scheduler will email you asking you to confirm that you would like to be scheduled. Tee times and pairings will be emailed to you two days before play. The scheduler cannot make changes after 9:00 a.m. the day before play, at which time the final schedule is sent to the golf course. The golf course will confirm your tee time via email.
- If a last-minute cancellation is necessary, please notify the scheduler by text/phone and notify the pro shop. **Do not cancel online because this opens the slot to the public. As a courtesy, notify your playing partners for that day if you are unable to play.**
- **Members are not allowed to change their own starting times on the website or spontaneously at the course.** Members are expected to play with the group to which they have been assigned. All members are strongly encouraged to play 2/3 of the available dates in their leagues' schedule
- Cancellation of Play: If golf is cancelled due to weather conditions or course conditions, you will be notified by email. Cancellation will also be posted at golfwilmette.com.

- **Day of Play**

- Arrive at the golf course at least 15 minutes prior to your tee time and check in at the pro shop. Request a cart if you choose and pay your fees.
- Proceed to the starter shack (in cart, if riding) with your clubs and check in with starter. Let him know if you are going to the range.
- 10 minutes before tee time, join your group at the starter shack and get scorecards and any instructions for the day's event. Each group must keep two scorecards for the entire group. Hole by hole scores and putts should be recorded. Birdies and chip-ins should be indicated by circling the score for that hole. At the end of play, the scorecards should be checked for accuracy and

signed, attested to and dated. Both scorecards must be turned into the tournament director immediately, as they serve as the official record of play for that day.

- **Each player must enter her hole-by-hole score into the CDGA website or APP by the end of the day of play.** Most members take a screen shot of their scorecard so they can enter their scores shortly after the round.

- **Competition**

- Each day of play has an event scheduled. These events are listed on the calendar on the WGA website (wgawilmette.com) and will be announced by the starter. After play, the tournament director will score the event and, within a day or two, notify the members with results via email.
- Competition will be by divisions according to handicap. Weekly prizes are awarded for low putts and event winners within each division. The descriptions of weekly prizes and seasonal prizes can be found on the website.

- **Socializing/Lunch**

- Players are encouraged to stay for lunch. There will be a designated area just below the patio for WGA golfers. You're welcome to join any table with other players. A special menu with snack bar items and a few items from The Lawn menu, will be offered. A wait person will be available to this area.

- **Special events for this season**
